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MARKET OPPORTUNITY REMOTE PREEMPTION & PRIORITY

Problem statements:


- ➤ Emergencies responders aren't meeting response times, due to lack of and/or failing preemption system.
- ➤ Line of sight technologies do not provide enough notice to clear queues.
- Established technologies require installation and maintenance of onboard, roadside, and often central software.
- > Established technologies are expensive
 - ➤ Approx. \$15,000 per intersection (installation)
 - > \$9,000,000 for 600 intersections

Solution:

- Process existing AVL data and generate signal preemption/priority requests
- Execute the priority requests via central system and existing communication infrastructure

Benefits:

- Significantly less expensive and faster deployment
- Single source of operational commands
